#### At a later stage, the successful applicant will also hold the role of:

- Medical Director of the Department of Gynecology and Obstetrics of the Ente Ospedaliero Cantonale (EOC), which is currently under the process of being established.

#### Essential criteria:

- Post-graduate degree in Gynecology and Obstetrics pursuant to art. 20 and 21 of the Federal Law on University Medical Professions (LPMed). Mebeko recognition is required for foreign qualifications.
- In-depth training and solid experience in the field of Oncological Gynecology.
- Academic qualifications in Gynecology and Obstetrics (Associate or Full Professor) in a Swiss or foreign university.
- Solid and proven clinical and managerial experience in running an efficacious Gynecology and Obstetrics department.
- Solid and proven experience in conducting a research program (basic, translational and/or clinical).
- Willingness to collaborate with an established team of specialists active in the various fields of Gynecology and Obstetrics, both at the Lugano site and in other sites within the EOC, to assist in furthering the development of the specialty and maintaining clinical excellence.
- Willingness to continue and strengthen the collaboration with general practitioners, practicing specialists and other key stakeholders.
- Commitment to fostering the academic development of co-workers, ensuring continuity with the existing activities.
- Commitment to academic teaching, to the development of basic and continuing education in Gynecology and Obstetrics and a marked interest in scientific research.
- Willingness to collaborate with the members of the Faculty of Biomedical Sciences of the Università della Svizzera Italiana (USI) for the definition and implementation of study paths and for the development of research within the Faculty.
- Adequate knowledge of Italian, English and preferably other national languages.
